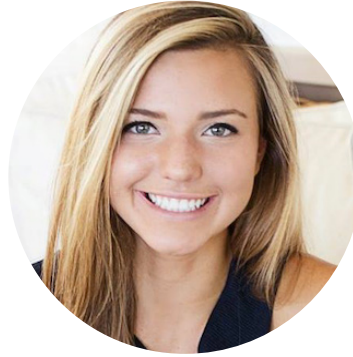
MARISA HELF
